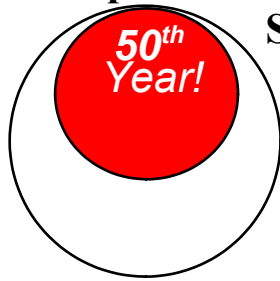

- Saturday is a full day fee (not a half day) that includes registration for the afternoon Goodwill Tournament. All camp participants are encouraged and expected to participate or attend as spectators

- Two half-day sessions on different days may not be combined as 1 full day; they will be charged as two half-days.
- No refunds once camp starts.

III. REGISTRATION DEADLINE

V. EXAMINATIONS

Kyu Examination: Saturday, July 13 at 1:45pm

Dan Examination: Sunday, July 14 at 12:30pm

Dan Exam Fees will be announced one month prior to camp.

Dan/kyu exam registration will be held from 5-6pm on Wed, Thurs, and Fri in the Dorm, from 1:30-2:30 pm on Sat, and 11-12pm Sun in the Gym. Applicants must have permission from their instructor, bring current JKA Passport (Dan) or annual membership card (kyu), completed application, and cash (US\$)

VI. JKA QUALIFICATION COURSE

(For Instructors and Students Nidan or Above, at the gym)
