**HOW TO GET THERE:**

**MAESTRO Dojo:** Map 48 West 68 street, NY 10023 (between Central Park West + Columbus Av.)

Subway: #1 train 66<sup>th</sup> street station to the Columbus Ave. Walk north, turn right on 68 street.

A,B,C train to 72 street station. Walk CPW south to 68 street. Go 48 Maestro.

**MMAC Dojo:** Map 248 West 60 street, NY 10023 (bet Westend (11<sup>th</sup>) Ave + Amsterdam (10<sup>th</sup>) Ave.)

Subway: 1, A, B, C, D train to the 59<sup>th</sup> Columbus Circle station, 3 blocks.

Walk west along the west 60<sup>th</sup> street. Look for the 248 MMAC entrance on your left.

**NJ Dojo:** 8 Bay view Ave. Englewood Clif, New Jersey, NJ 07632 (Japanese Children's School Gym)

Subway: A train to the 175<sup>th</sup> st, George Washington Bridge. Change to NJ transit #186 to Bay view Ave.

**MMAC Dojo:** 248 W 60 st, bet Westend Av+Amsterdam Av.  
Subway: 1, A, B, C, D train to the 59<sup>th</sup> Columbus Circle station.  
Go to west 60<sup>th</sup> st. to 248 west, MMAC entrance is on your left.



**MAESTRO Dojo:** 48 W 68 street, bet. CPW+Columbus Av.  
1 train 66<sup>th</sup> st. station to the Columbus Ave. turn right on 68 st.  
B,C train to 72nd st station. Walk CPW down south to 68 st.
